This week, school has met with various members of Herts County Council transport, roads and safety departments to discuss the plans for two proposed Zebra crossings close to school. While this is not a 100% guarantee, this is top of HCC's priority list and something we are confident will be completed within the financial year. Through support from School Governors who also work as local councillors we have worked tirelessly to improve the safety of roads around school.

One of the proposed sites is on Woodland Road very close to the school entrance and the other on Hornhill near the junction with Woodland Road. The yellow no parking lines will also be redrawn.

Financial support for the projects comes from HS2 who are also working with school to support other plans and developments.
