Year 6 – Crime and Punishment

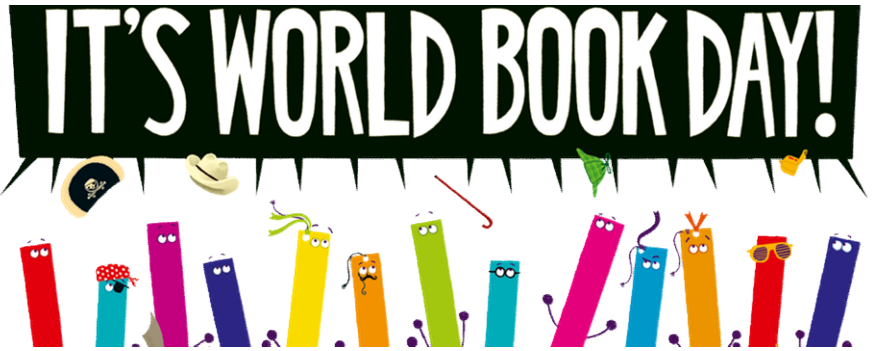
